Reception

In RE we have been thinking about places that are special to us, and why they are so important. We learned that a church is a special place for Christians, to talk to God and be part of a community of worship. We looked at images of churches and looked for things they have in common so that we can spot them in our community. In Maths we have been learning about numbers to 20, and making these amounts using cubes, counters and Numicon shapes. Next week we will try and count even higher and think about the number patterns. In Literacy we have enjoyed the story of Farmer Duck. We have written about the mean old farmer and have retold the story using words and pictures.

Year 1

Last week in English we looked at the book, 'The Wide, Wide Sea'. We learnt about lots of different things we might find at the seaside like whelks and barnacles, gulls and gannets.

This week, we have read "Tiddler" and were telling our own 'tall tales'. In Maths we have been continuing to count in 2s, 5s, and 10s. and looking at multiplication arrays.

The KS1 Team have been busy Planning our Trip. As we are learning about the Seaside and Blackpool, we have booked to visit Blackpool

Tower on the 9th July. Whilst there, we will take a trip up the Eye and then experience some seaside entertainment at the Circus. The cost of the trip will be £19 (details to follow).
